VOUTH VOTE 2020 MOCK FLECTION

Every election cycle since 2000, Youth Vote has conducted a mock election for students in Anchorage. The mock election ballot includes candidates for President/Vice President and Alaska's candidates for US House of Representatives and the US Senate.

The mock election ballot also includes measures that reflect the current ballot as well as youth created measures.





CANDIDATE INFORMATION
